



10 Promises to Live By



God told Joshua,

"This book of instruction must not depart from your mouth; you are to recite it day and night so that you may carefully observe everything written in it. For then you will prosper and succeed in whatever you do."

Joshua 1:8



And Paul said, in Romans 10:17, " So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the message about Christ."

I will instruct you and show you the way to go; with My eye on you, I will give counsel.

Psalms 32:8

Haven't I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

Joshua 1:9

Ways to use these promises:

- Meditate on them each day as you get started.
- Memorize them!
- Make them personal, use them in your prayer time. Here is an example. "Lord, I thank You according to Psalms 32:8 that you will instruct me today. That you will show me the way that I should act and respond to my day."
- Set a trigger action, like whenever you take a drink of water or coffee or whatever. When you do that, take a moment to recite one Scripture in your head. Maybe you use it in a quick prayer. (see #3 above)
